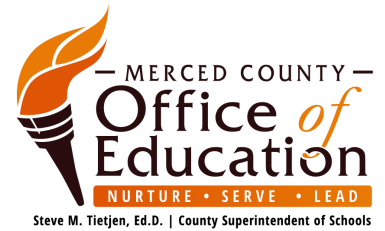
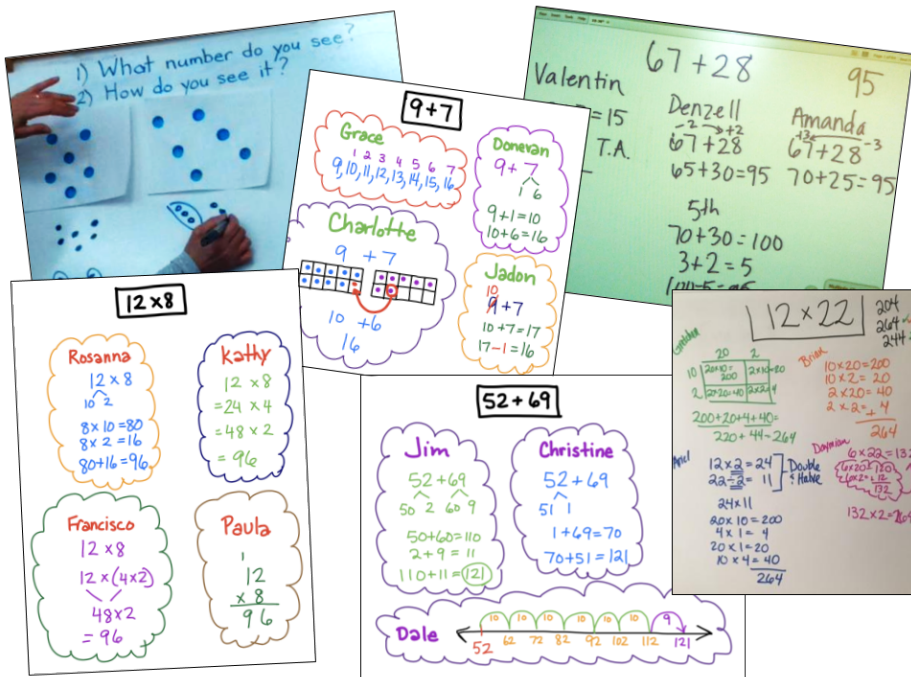


Number Talks

A number talk is a five-to-fifteen minute math routine around purposefully selected problems that are solved mentally. Learn how to...

- Conduct an effective number talk.
- Include ALL your students: ELL, Special Ed, high-flyers, and strugglers.
- Follow students' thinking and strategically document their thinking to build conceptual understanding in mathematics.
- Connect student thinking to visual models such as empty number line, ten-frame, base ten blocks, number disks, etc.
- Make number talks the favorite part of the day for you and your students!
